The role

You will be a link to current in school practice for your subject for our Secondary Trainees. You will share experience, resources, advice and encouragement for these trainees in their first year of the programme.

You will support subject development leads to instil a passion and confidence for the subjects, as well as robust, domain specific subject knowledge in our trainees.

You will do this through monitoring and engaging in online discussion forums, responding to ideas they have shared and answering subject specific questions they have.

- Supporting DLs in monitoring a subject specific discussion board on Brightspace (20 mins/week)
- Responding to trainee questions, concerns and requests for support within the teach meet/on the discussion board by drawing on your own experience-es and training
- Sharing/signposting planning and resources as requested/appropriate

This role is completely online

About you

- You are currently or have recently been the leader of the subject for which you are applying
- You have access to planning, resources and knowledge of good practice within your subject
- Ideally, you may have experience of mentoring students, or accredited training in your subject (eg NPQML or MAT/LA subject training)

In return

In this first, pilot, year of this approach we cannot pay our subject specialist ambassadors. In addition to being able to contribute to our movement to end educational inequality, we're keen that this is a valuable role for all of our Subject Ambassadors. To support recognition and career development of our Subject Ambassadors we can offer:
